The trustees of St Macartan's Youth & Community Centre are pleased to submit their report and accounts for the period April 1st 2016 to March 31st 2017.

In the year to March 2017 St Macartan's Youth & Community Centre continued to promote the benefit of the people living in Augher and the surrounding rural area.

We ran four nights a week offering a variety of programmes such as indoor football, cookery, art and dance class. We had a very successful summer scheme programme which ran for four weeks in July from 10am until 1pm with up to 120 children attending daily.

Three of our older members became volunteer leaders with the hope of going on to do their leaders course when they reach the appropriate age.

The group is managed by a management committee with 8 members. This year our long serving treasurer, Mrs Ann McGinn, resigned from her post after 30 years of service. She was thanked very much for all her work and given a small presentation to mark her retirement. One of the other members, Mr. Michael Gormley has stepped into her post. As a committee we feel we need to get more young parents involved in the committee in the coming year. There were 5 committee meetings during the year which were well attended and the main purpose of these meetings is to give support to the youth club leaders.

We are a voluntary part time youth club and get funding from the education authority with whom we have a service level agreement.

We continue to promote the benefit of the inhabitants of Augher and its environs by providing or assisting in the provision of facilities for recreation or other leisure time occupation, in the interests of social welfare, and with the object of improving the conditions of life for the said inhabitants, without distinction of age, sex, race, political, religious or other opinion.
