




We make these sports accessible with the help of specialised equipment, such as a hoist at Foyle Port Marina; accessible boats; access to the water via pontoons at Foyle Port Marina and Greencastle Co Donegal; and support from trained and qualified volunteers.

To further these purposes for the public benefit, we carried out the following activities:

Fortnightly on the water group boating experiences and individual sail training sessions and annual regattas together with classroom-based training.

January 28th and we got out on the water ! Beautiful day enjoyed by Ken, Catherine, Eoin, Niamh, Cara and Claire. Feb 12th and Rebecca and Shirley got out with Ken and Derek Furniss, Marty Haire and Reggie Downey.

February started well with Catherine, Kieran, Niamh and Ken completing their RYA First Aid, and we managed another few hours sailing on Sun 12th.

5th March and we had another good turnout with two hansas out. Lot of background work from Reggie, the two Marty's, Pdraig, Sean, Catherine with maintenance and tidying up etc plus plans for funding efforts.

April saw our first recognition night at Lough Foyle Yacht Club, Culmore. John Pollock received a gift from us all for his service as treasurer for the past few years, and our sailors got recognised for their part in retaining the President's Cup. Eoin, Niamh, Marty and Pdraig started work on the wild flower display at Prehen.

We managed to get another couple of days sailing in May and more maintenance work done.

In June we took a couple of groups from the Foyle Ambassadors scheme out for trips and Ken completed the Jester Baltimore Challenge and managed to raise a few quid for club funds in the process. In July we traveled to lough Erne to support Marty in his marvellous fund-raising effort and then back up again for the sailability regatta. This turned out to be a great day out for everyone despite the weather.

August's highlight for us was the Belfast lough sailability regatta which took place for the Hansas within Carrickfergus harbour. A really enjoyable days racing was had by all and foyle secured their first race win at any regatta ! We managed to sell Eoin's old boat but kept the outboard to use on the incoming Hawk 20.

Downes Syndrome Trust joined us for a trip on a beautiful evening down river at the start of September. We had a couple of great days sailing the Hawk at Prehen with sailors learning how to helm with a tiller. We even practised rescuing our rescue boat !



We took ownership of our second Hawk at the start of October. This of course was only possible with Kieran McAllister's help in securing the donation from Cable Accessories. We cannot thank C&A and Kieran in particular enough for the support every single year.

Catherine and Pdraig attended the Supported Communities event in November and made some very good connections which I'm sure will prove fruitful in the future. They both have been working away in the background for many months trying to find ways of securing funding. This is an important task which we have been struggling with since our inception, but hopefully there's a brighter future for FS due to their efforts.

All in all, not a bad year for Foyle Sailability. Good connections have been made. Hopefully the weather gods will be kind to us in 2024 and enable us to get more time on the water. We are looking at all ways of creating more opportunities to sail.




The main achievements of the Charity in the year were:

2022 began with us all still under the Covid cloud. Thankfully things eased gradually, but the weather decided that we were not going to get back to normal as regards sailing. It seemed that every time we planned to get on the water, the wind and rain were against us.

After many years, we eventually were given access to the Derry City and Strabane Council compound at Prehen for storing some of our boats and equipment and late in the year we eventually had access to the new pontoon which has proved to be an excellent facility.

Thankfully the season wasn't total lost when we entered four sailors in the President's cup in Carrickfergus run by Belfast Lough Sailability. All did well in the Hanses in what became quite lumpy conditions. Despite the lack of training throughout the season they all competed well with a big improvement in standards from previous years. We competed along with Belfast Lough Sailability and Lough Erne Sailability as team Ulster. After winning the President's cup in 2021 for the first time, we managed to retain it this year. A great achievement by everyone.

We participated in two days at the Lough Foyle Maritime Festival providing mainly on the water experiences to the disabled which was well received even though the weather was pretty awful most of the time.

We welcomed some new members joining us this year, and also managed to put another three members through the Powerboat Level 2 training and along with the other volunteers that already have the qualification they will be great assets to the club.



Looking forward to 2023 we are hoping for good sailing weather and to make full use of the new pontoon and facilities at Prehen.
