Treasurers Report Year End 2024-25

This year we generated an income of **£10,661.81** (including National Lottery grant) an increase of £1020.56 on last year. We had increased revenue from our bingo £203.24, a slight decrease in membership of £130. We were fortunate enough to secure another grant from the National Lottery of £8,300 which is greatly appreciated.

Are expenditure for the year was **£6,765.65** The increase in expenditure of £ 1664.75 was an increase in activities for our members, our insurance increased slightly by £41, but it is the same for all clubs in this current climate.

Our funding made our accounts on the 31/01/2025 of **£8,300.00** this will enable the club to provide more activities for our members in the next financial year to come.

The balance in the club Account was **£10,008.11** which will ensure another great year for the club and its members.
