#### **Public benefit requirement statutory guidance**

The Trustees have had regard to the Charity commission NI's public benefit requirement statutory guidance and are satisfied that the Charity complies with said guidance.

#### **Purpose of the charity**

The Club is established to promote the benefit of persons with visual impairments living within County Fermanagh (hereinafter called the "area of benefit") without distinction of age, gender, sexual orientation, nationality, ethnic identity, disability, political or religious opinion, by association with the inhabitants, voluntary organisations and the statutory authorities in a common effort to alleviate poverty and disadvantage, advance education, promote social inclusion, promote cross-community contact, promote social welfare for recreation or other leisure-time occupation, with the object of improving the conditions of life for the said persons with visual impairments.

#### **Summary of Fermanagh Visually Impaired person Clubs Activities**

The Awards for All Grant carried over into 2018 providing the club with funding for the following activities: pottery, flower arranging, healthy eating demo., bowling and 2 day trips i.e. BBQ at Lusty Beg Island and a trip to the beach at Rossnowleagh.

The Club secured a small grant through LCDI to provide a volunteer recognition event, this included visual awareness training and an opportunity to ensure that all volunteers are familiar with the Club's Vulnerable Adults Policy.


#### **Financial Review**
