### **Public benefit requirement statutory guidance**

The Trustees have had regard to the Charity commission NI's public benefit requirement statutory guidance and are satisfied that the Charity complies with said guidance.

### **Purpose of the charity**

The Club is established to promote the benefit of persons with visual impairments living within County Fermanagh (hereinafter called the "area of benefit") without distinction of age, gender, sexual orientation, nationality, ethnic identity, disability, political or religious opinion, by association with the inhabitants, voluntary organisations and the statutory authorities in a common effort to alleviate poverty and disadvantage, advance education, promote social inclusion, promote cross-community contact, promote social welfare for recreation or other leisure-time occupation, with the object of improving the conditions of life for the said persons with visual impairments.

### **Summary of Fermanagh Visually Impaired person Clubs Activities**

*The Club have maintained twice monthly meetings with good attendance at meetings. A number of day trips were held during the year and the members also enjoyed speakers from local museum who spoke on a number of topics relevant to the Fermanagh area. A small grant from the Community Foundation enabled members to take part in arts and crafts and also provide transport for the Christmas party in December 2019.*
