Trustee's Report for year 2022 to 2023

Magheraveely Sunshine Club was established for the advancement of education, health and enjoyment of the over 50's in Magheraveely and surrounding rural area. We aim to reduce isolation by bringing people together and reduce poverty by sourcing funding where we can to subsidise the cost of our activities.

We provide monthly lunchtime outings to local hotels and restaurants in the area, we provide transport to these luncheon events where we have a 3-course hot meal and some form of entertainment such as music, exercise, a speaker on different topics of interest to our members.

We also have coffee mornings and craft classes to enrich the lives of our members, most recently our members learned how to fill window boxes, make decorations from scrap fabrics and paint and draw, we source local tutors for our activities.

Our membership has reached almost 100 members now and we are regularly receiving membership requests.

We sometimes join with other local groups to share learning and create new friendships and interests, the most recent ones being with a Magheraveely Development Association and the local Men's Shed.

The Trustees and Committee work voluntarily to fulfil our obligations as set out in our Constitution and those laid out by funders we work with and the Charity Commission.
