
We continue to visit the sick who cannot attend our church services. This is a vital part of church ministry as we encourage them in their faith acknowledging they are still a valued member of the church.

We remain thankful to God for His faithfulness, He is the same yesterday, today and forever. As we acknowledge God never fails, we can again look to Him for our everyday blessings


On reviewing our accounts, we give thanks for every offering. God has continued to provide, and we know our future and our hope is in Him
