Annual report

Annual Report for Tiny Tots Preschool Stewartstown June 2024

Curriculum

We follow a curriculum which operates under 6 areas of learning through weekly, monthly, termly and long term planning. The six areas are: 1) Personal, Social and Emotional Development, 2) Physical Development and Movement, 3) Language Development, 4) Early Mathematical Experiences, 5) The Arts and 6) The World Around Us. Through this curriculum we seek to identify specific needs for each individual child and provide opportunities for further development. The preschool welcomes children from all communities in Stewartstown and the surrounding area. As part of the PEAGS Initiative we have an Early Years Adviser Nuala McCormack. She visited us during the year to advise us on the day to day running of the playgroup and Child Development. She was also responsible for organising the Cluster training days which we attended. In September 2023 we had 19 children on the register in their preschool year availing of PEAGS places.

Staff
