During the year we applied to Antrim and Newtownabbey Borough Council for funding and we were successful with two applications.

We received £500.00 towards insurance and hall rental and a further £500.00 towards a Senior Citizens Christmas party which was held in the Ramble Inn.

We also applied for and were successful in getting a grant of £1000.00 for a Warm Well Connected, this grant allowed us to provide 16 weeks of indoor bowling during the day and also allowed us to provide hot food, (soup and wheaten bread) to an average of 15 people each day. Many thanks to the council for these grants.

Going forward we shall not receive the insurance and hall rental grant for the incoming year as the council has changed their criteria for this grant.

I would like to thank the office bearers and committee members for their support during the past year.

Whilst I did enjoy the bowling during the season, not some of the results, I think that at the next Mid Antrim AGM, we should asked that the home teams should supply tea and biscuits as previously.
