A summary of the Charity's main activities and achievements in the year	<p>These are the main activities undertaken by this Charity to further its charitable purposes for the public benefit of its beneficiaries.</p> <p>The Beaver and Cub Sections of the Group have remained active: Beavers aged 6-8 years and Cubs aged 8-10 years. The Scout section of the Group, aged between 10-14 years, recommenced in September 2022 after many years' absence.</p>

	<p>Section meetings take place weekly during term-time, following a structured programme of age-related games and activities, to engage and support young people in their personal development, empowering them to make a positive contribution to society.</p> <p>The Group has had a busy year, with Beavers, Cubs and Scouts meeting on a weekly basis. For the 2022/23 year, there were 13 Beavers, 26 Cubs & 9 Scouts.</p> <p>We played games, undertook badge work and used online programme suggestions provided by the Scout Association.</p> <p>However, through our weekly activities, Beavers gained the following badges:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • International • Communicator • Health & Fitness • Book Reader <p>Cubs gained the following badges:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Home Help • Hobbies • Artist • Book Reader <p>Beavers, Cubs and Scouts undertook local activities as well as participating in a number of NI and County activities during the 2022/23 year including Beaver Rally Day, visit to local pumpkin patch, Cub Quiz, bowling, dodgeball to name a few.</p> <p>Funds are allocated to activities and events which are both enjoyable and encourage the young people to become more independent and self-reliant, developing teamwork and skills for life.</p>
