A summary of the Charity's main activities and achievements in the year	<p>These are the main activities undertaken by this Charity to further its charitable purposes for the public benefit of its beneficiaries.</p> <p>The Beaver and Cub Sections of the Group have remained active: Beavers aged 6-8 years and Cubs aged 8-10 years. The Scout section of the Group, aged between 10-14 years, recommenced in September 2022 after many years' absence and the Group has also established an Explorer section in the latter part of 2023/24 year.</p>

	<p>Section meetings take place weekly during term-time, following a structured programme of age-related games and activities, to engage and support young people in their personal development, empowering them to make a positive contribution to society.</p> <p>The Group has had a busy year, with Beavers, Cubs, Scouts and Explorers meeting on a weekly basis. For the 2023/24 year, there were 16 Beavers, 33 Cubs, 16 Scouts and 2 Explorers.</p> <p>We played games, undertook badge work and used online programme suggestions provided by the Scout Association.</p> <p>Through our weekly activities, Beavers gained the following badges:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• My World• My Adventure• My Teamwork• Cook• Experiment <p>Cubs gained the following badges:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Emergency Aid Stage 1• Navigation Stage 1• Paddle Sports Stage 1• Nights Away 3/5 <p>Scouts gained the following badges:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Entertainer• Community Impact• Nights Away• Air Activities Stage 3 <p>Beavers, Cubs, Scouts and Explorers undertook local activities as well as participating in a number of NI and County activities during the 2023/24 year including Beaver Rally Day, Cub Quiz, Cub and Scout bowling/football/dodgeball competitions, SCub (Cub/Scout) camp to name a few.</p> <p>Funds are allocated to activities and events which are both enjoyable and encourage the young people to become more independent and self-reliant, developing teamwork and skills for life.</p>
