<b>A summary of the Charity's main activities and achievements in the year</b>	<p>These are the main activities undertaken by this Charity to further its charitable purposes for the public benefit of its beneficiaries.</p> <p>The Beaver and Cub Sections of the Group have remained active: Beavers aged 6-8 years and Cubs aged 8-10 years. The Scout section of the Group, aged between 10-14 years, recommenced in September 2022 after many years' absence and the Group also established an Explorer section in the latter part of 2023/24 year.</p>

Section meetings take place weekly during term-time, following a structured programme of age-related games and activities, to engage and support young people in their personal development, empowering them to make a positive contribution to society.

The Group has had a busy year, with Beavers, Cubs, Scouts and Explorers meeting on a weekly basis. For the 2024/25 year, there were 17 Beavers, 26 Cubs, 17 Scouts and 4 Explorers.

We played games, undertook badge work and used online programme suggestions provided by the Scout Association.
