

BASIS OF OPINION.

I carried out my examination under paragraphs 46(b) and 240(1) of the Code.

Nothing has come to my attention in connection with our examination which gives me reasonable cause to believe that in any material respect:

- a) The accounting records have not been kept in respect of the Congregation in accordance with the Code.
- b) The accounts for the year ended do not accord with those records.
- c) The accounts do not comply with any of the requirements of the Code. However i am not required to and do not express an opinion on whether the accounts give a true and fair view.

Further nothing has come to my attention in connection with my examination that in my opinion should be drawn to your attention in order to enable a proper understanding of the accounts to be reached.
