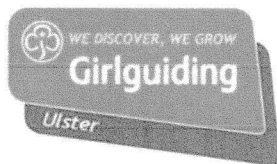

Activities included spring walks, Halloween and Christmas parties, spring walks, promise making activities, baking, crafts, games and lots more throughout the term!

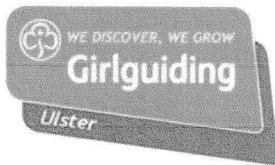
The brownies took part in a joint Children in Need danceathon with the guides – raising £364 for charity).
