

## **Tyrone County Scouts Report – March 2018 - April 2018**

Tyrone County Scouts operate within the County to provide support to various registered Scouting Groups within the County. For the current year we have Scout Groups in the following areas:

- The cub section took part in various activities including football competition, hikes and table quiz
- Scouts took part in a table quiz, hiking competitions, climbing competition, archery competition and raft building event.
- Explorers were ran independently and have various trips, hike, expeditions with various groups also competing and being awarded Duke of Edinburgh Awards at various levels.
- Leaders continued with various training course including Woodbadge Training, First Aid, Safe Guarding and Leadership/Management courses.
