Structure, governance and management

Church Hill Community Development Association is an unincorporated Association. The Association was formed on 25 September 2006 and its governing instrument is its Constitution.

The Charity is administered by its officers. Officers are sought according to the needs of the Charity by an Executive Committee consisting of a minimum of five members.

Financial review and achievements

The Charity's deficit for the year amounted to £2,604 (2020 – deficit £17,490).

Cash funds at the year end were £57, consisting of unrestricted funds of £334 and restricted funds of £(277).

The Charity plans to carry out an extension to the community hall and incurred further preliminary expenses in respect of this during the year.

During the year the Charity held a number of community events in support of a fundraising appeal.
