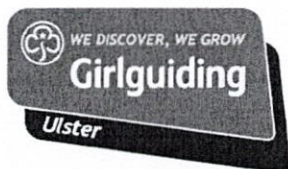

A summary of the Charity's main activities to further its purposes for the public benefit and the main achievements in the year
