Girls were able to have a games night to get started and back into a normal routine each week. They also took part in crafts each week. Rainbows took part in several Christmas crafts and concluded with Glitterbug and Jumping Clay coming for two joint nights with Rainbows and Brownies to make mini snowmen one week and slime the next as their final nights prior to Christmas.
