## **Independent Examiners Report to the Trustees of First Newry (Sandys Street) Presbyterian Church**

I confirm that I have examined the accounts and records of the of the Congregational Accounts of First Newry (Sandys Street) Presbyterian Church in as far as they were presented to me for the year ended 31 December 2022.
