Activities

Purposes: The company's Objects ("Objects") are specifically restricted to the following: to relieve suffering and distress and promote the benefit of the inhabitants of Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland (hereinafter called the area of benefit) by associating the statutory authorities, community and voluntary organisations and the inhabitants in a common effort to relieve those affected by conflict and sectarianism, promote good community relations and advance education and in particular: (a) to alleviate suffering and trauma by assisting victims and survivors of the Conflict within the area of benefit to address their own personal experiences of hurt, loss and trauma by communicating their experiences to others and to support victims and survivors of the Conflict, and those who work with them, to work towards healing processes and dealing with the past in a way that allows people to move towards a shared future; (b) to provide opportunities for cross community and intra- community dialogue which build and maintain mutual understanding and respect within and between communities by bringing together individuals from diverse backgrounds in a safe environment to tell and hear their stories and facilitating dialogue that allows people from different backgrounds and cultural traditions to speak fully and be listened to, whilst creating opportunities for the exploration of each other's ideology, perceptions, attitudes, and sense of history; (c) to advance understanding of the effects of the conflict and sectarianism on individuals and communities and public awareness of the personal experience of those affected; (d) to advance any other exclusively charitable purpose for the benefit of the inhabitants of Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland as the directors may, from time to time, decide in accordance with the law of charity.
