

TREASURER'S REPORT 2024

This 2024 Report basically shows an increase in both income and expenditure with overall income up around £3,000 and overall expenses by a similar amount. Weekly envelopes have stalled at just over the £30,000.00 but Annual Stipend payments increased from around £32,000 to over £36,000 an increase of about 12 per cent.

Newspapers collections have slowed down and we did manage to get away a load early in the year mostly from 2022. Easter and Harvest envelopes have shown little increase while Christmas envelopes fell by 50%.

The Auction was again a good success raising over £2,319. 00 as was the Concert which raised £860. We also incurred an expense of £1,740 for a new roof on Rectory Kitchen while against that we saved over £1,000 on heat and light.

Unfortunately there is still a large number of Parishioners who failed to make any contribution during the year, (Especially the younger Parishioners). We need the financial support from A L L of our Parishioners, both young and old, no matter how little (according to means) to survive after these difficult times and we do understand how difficult it is financially for some people but we must financially meet our commitments as a Parish otherwise our Rector will not be replaced and ultimately the Church Authorities would deem the Parish unsustainable and same would be closed.
