**Structure, governance and management**

The Granaghan Outreach Charitable Trust was established in 2007 and was set up by way of a Trust Deed dated 5th March 2007. The charitable trust constituted by this deed (the charity) and its property (the Trust Fund) shall be administered and managed by the trustees under the name of Granaghan Outreach Charitable Trust or by such other name as the trustees from time to time decide. There is no remuneration of any nature made to the Trustees.

Board of Trustees

The Trust is managed by a Board of Trustees which meets on a regular basis and is chaired by Miss. Maeve Quinn.

The appointment of new Trustees is made by a resolution to the existing Trustees passed at a special meeting.

Administration

The administration of the Trust is undertaken by the Treasurer, Paul Ward. Important decisions are carried out only with the approval of the Board of Trustees.

**Objectives and activities**

The objects of the trust are exclusively charitable being the promotion and provision of educational, social, vocational, cultural and recreational facilities and relief of poverty for the communities at home and abroad where these objects provide relief and are needed.

### **Achievement and performance**

During the year the Charity continued to fund trusted missionaries with their work.

### **Financial review**

During the year Granaghan Outreach has continued to raise funds through various collections and donations. The Charity made a surplus of £10,835. This is shown in the Statement of Receipts and Payments Account on page 5.

**1 General information**

The charity is a registered charity in Northern Ireland and is unincorporated. The address of the principal office is Granaghan Resource Centre, Main Street, Swatragh, Co. Derry, BT46 5GB.

**2 Statement of compliance**

These financial statements accounts have been prepared in compliance with FRS 102, 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and the Republic of Ireland', the Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (Charities SORP (FRS 102)) and the Charities Act (Northern Ireland) 2008.

**3 Accounting policies**

**Basis of preparation**

The financial statements accounts have been prepared on the historical cost basis, as modified by the revaluation of certain financial assets and liabilities and investment properties measured at fair value through income or expenditure

The financial statements accounts are prepared in sterling, which is the functional currency of the entity.

**Going concern**

There are no material uncertainties about the charity's ability to continue.

**4 Taxation**

Granaghan Outreach Charitable Trust is registered as a charity for tax purposes with HM Revenue and accordingly is exempt from taxation. HMRC reference number - XT5466.
