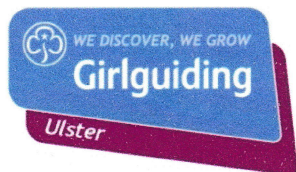

A summary of the Charity's main activities to further its purposes for the public benefit and the main achievements in the year

1st Greyabbey Guides is a group of girls aged between 10 and 14 years old, who meet on a Thursday evening September to May (with breaks corresponding with school holidays), from 6.30pm to 7.45pm. This year, the unit increased to eleven members, with girls moving up from the local Brownie unit.

During the year the Guides took part in usual unit activities, including games, badge work and craft. At the beginning of the year, the unit was selected by Girlguiding UK to be part of the testing pool for new resources, and come September when the new programme went live, the unit spent meetings working on new activities, skills builders, and badges.

Three guides also started work on their Baden-Powell Award.
