**A summary of the Charity's main activities to further its purposes for the public benefit and the main achievements in the year**

11<sup>th</sup> Bangor Brownies is a group of girls aged between 7 years old and 10 years old.

During the year September 2022 – June 2023, most of those on our roll from pre-Covid lockdowns have turned 10 and moved out of the Brownie age group into that of Guides.

During the year, following the Covid lockdowns and attendant challenges in meeting face-to-face experienced in the previous year and on into this, we have not as yet recommenced standard unit meetings. The major issue is that we do not currently have sufficient leaders who can guarantee their availability on a Monday night to allow the unit to run safely. However, we hope to be able to reopen in September 2023 if we can find sufficient leaders.
