


FEED MY LAMBS CHILDREN'S MINISTRY



Annual Report 2023

Feed my Lambs Children's Ministry (Registered in Northern Ireland as a Charity NIC 105989 and in Kenya as a Society 28773) is a Christian based organisation which works primarily in Kenya and Uganda but also in Northern Ireland. Our main purpose is to bring the Gospel to boys, girls and young people and to encourage, support and equip those who have a burden to reach out to those in their locality. We are governed by a Constitution which sets out the charity's purposes. Our base in Northern Ireland is at Dorchester Drive, Portadown and we have offices in Nairobi and Malaba. A fourth office was secured in Western Kenya in early 2019.

Our Ministries

Treasure Seekers Bible Lessons

This program consists of a series of 30 lessons which contain a Bible story, questions, memory verse to learn and activity such as a puzzle, crossword or colouring.

We continue to be encouraged by the uptake of this course both in Churches and Schools.

We are also glad to now have "Little Treasures" in operation. These are colouring pictures to match the lessons and which can be used with younger children who have also listened to the teaching.

We also now have visuals to accompany the lessons which can be used by teachers.

Bibles

We remain grateful that we still have Bibles in stock and ready for distribution thanks to the generosity of The Trinitarian Bible Society. TBS also have granted 1000 2024 calendars for distribution.

Training

Basic training continues via online courses with 4 new adults registering this year for ongoing training.

Training in Child Evangelism is planned for early 2024 in Kenya; in Nairobi and in Western province.

Library

The lending library continues to be in operation in Nairobi. However, although we still have members registered, use is decreasing as we increase distribution of materials for teachers to keep and own.

Support of local business

We continue to support local business as and when we can. Examples of this are the printing of manuals to be used at training; these are being printed by a local printing company in Nairobi. We also appreciate a local printing company in Northern Ireland who has assisted us in printing literature and resources.

Mission Trip

William and Pamela will be in Kenya in February and March of 2024 and will visit many centres and areas to teach and see the ministry first hand.

Home Ministry

It has been a privilege to again be able to share with adults throughout the country about the work of FML. This has been mainly in Churches. We have also had opportunities to share with children in Churches and in a BB about Kenya and what life is like there for boys and girls.

Our contact with Kenyans living locally in Northern Ireland has continued and we have valued opportunities to meet up with them and organise activities such as crafts for the children.

Their help has been invaluable in planning for the next trip to Kenya.

Prayer Partners

We are very thankful to have increased the number of people on our mailing list over the course of the past year. These new contacts have mainly been met at meetings where William and Pamela have been sharing about the ministry.

We are though saddened that some of our prayer partners have gone home to be with the Lord. Whilst this is sad for us, we know that for them, they are absent from the body and present with the Lord.


Finances
