The Guides participated in crafts, science projects, indoor and outdoor challenges, games, unit meeting activities, including Skills Builders – Be Well, Feel Good Stage 4 Awards gaining the Meditation Interest Badge and working on a Geocaching Interest Badge, participated in the Outdoor Challenge Event at Drum Manor Forest Park, Remembrance Sunday Parade, Thinking Day Event. Two Guides took part in their first residential two night event, taking part in caving, axe throwing, 3G swing and rock wall climbing at Crawfordsburn Scout Site.
