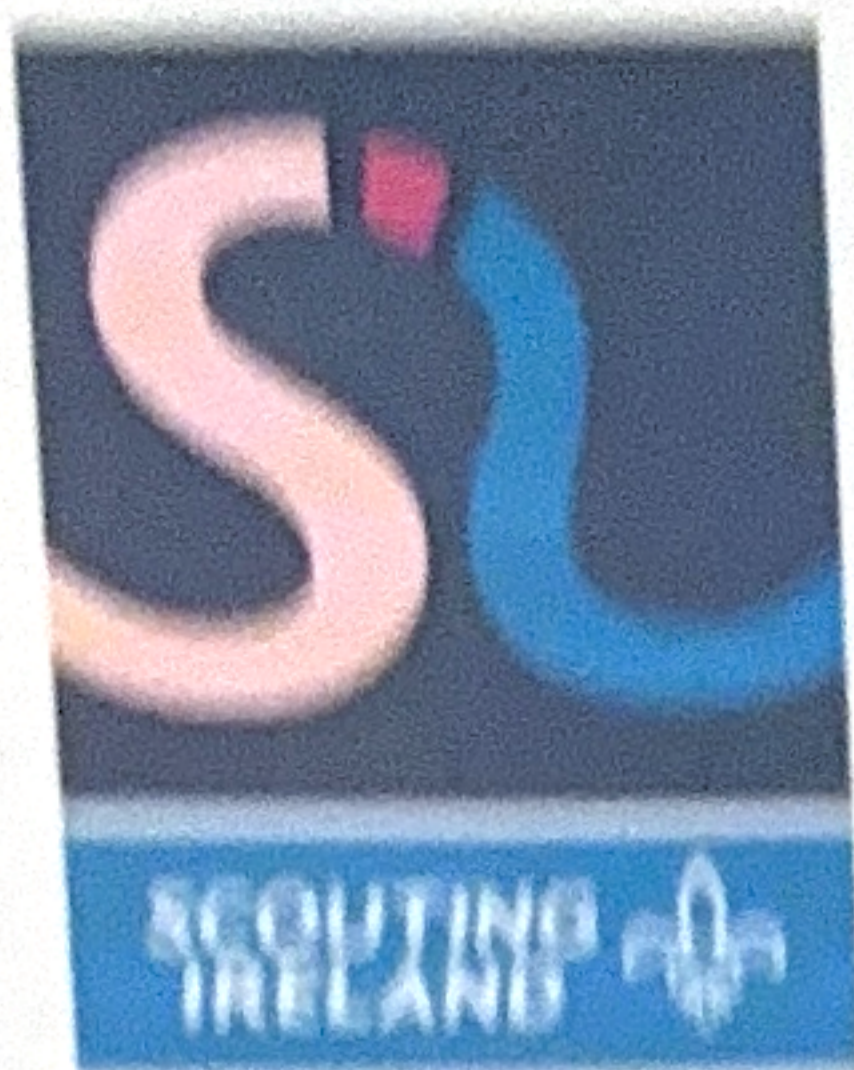

9. Charity's Main Activities and Achievements during the year.

The 4th Fermanagh Scouts group have had a very busy year in this scouting year 2023 to 2024. September was the first month the 4th Fermanagh Scouts got underway with an intake of 83.

October - Saw the beavers doing a trip to Castle Archdale for orienteering with the county and Scouts did a camp in Castle Archdale on 2 very cold nights. Cubs took part in the Emmetts Halloween event.

We had a very important night out for leaders this month and a few sore heads afterwards. Cubs enjoyed a Christmas night event cooling off after they explored the Land of Romans and went to Share for a swim.

January - Was a slow month with Scouts cancelling due to the storm and low attendance across the board with coughs and colds. Investiture was once again cancelled due to a delay in uniforms. But on the bright side, this was the month Elmarie got to join Cubs.

February - This month 2 of the venture scouts attended the county meetings and got to discuss upcoming plans for scouts in the county. This was the month Michelle joined Beavers. Cubs got details on their upcoming camp. We had a few new members join this month. Scouts completed an overnight in the hall and the uniforms arrived at last. Venture county scouts started this month in St.Micheals and the scouts did a hike on Slieve Beag. Investiture eventually happened with a great turnout and a lovely sense of celebration and relief.

March - Beavers went to Castle Archdale for Easter Egg Trail and Scouts moved to Crom for a few weeks to practise Skills. Cubs completed their totem pole preparations.

April - Scouts moved to Saturdays for a few weeks to get to do a few new things outside for longer but were hindered by the weather, Cubs got to do their Cross Community Island trip with the 1st Lisnaskea scouts. A fantastic exhilarating day of canoeing, bug hunting, fishing, orienteering and cooking. Beavers did the Big Fermanagh Litter Pick and Scouts made bird boxes sponsored by Mannok. Cubs got to cook their first sausages.

Elmarie and Kathleen attended the EA training.

May - Cubs went to build the bug hotels in Crom thanks to PJ from Scouts and Roisin Black in the national trust and all sections got to enjoy this great activity.

June - Scouts completed their sailing and cubs had water park fun with 1st Lisnaskea again in a second cross-community event. Beavers had a camp which was very enjoyable in Castle Saunderson, Scout went further afield to Donegal and Cubs had an interesting 3 night Jamboree in Athlone.

9. Charity's Main Activities and Achievements during the year.

The 4th Fermanagh Scouts group has had a very busy year in the scouting year 2022 to 2023. September was the first month the 4th Fermanagh Scouts got underway with an intake of 68 beavers, scouts, and cubs.

Autumn saw the group AGM where Claudine Marshall was appointed the new group leader and we said our farewell to Celine Gleeson as GL and made a presentation to thank her for her long-standing care of the Group. Celine remains in the group in the scout section. No other changes were made to the committees or trustees. A presentation to David Monaghan was held on behalf of the group on his retirement from County Commissioner. Autumn also saw the setting up of a parent association fundraising committee to raise funds for the group. A total of £3000 was raised over 4 weeks through raffles. Training was also held this autumn for leaders with several doing REC3 training and Hillwalking training in Gortin.

In December the scouts received the Bethlehem Peace Light in Enniskillen along with Northern Ireland Scouts and brought it back to Holy Cross Church Lisnaskea for their Investiture Ceremony. New uniforms were bought and much practice had and all had a successful investiture. The Scouts and Cubs also enjoyed a trip to the Share Ice Rink as a Christmas treat.

The new year saw the leaders set about organising a summer camp with the Isle of Man Venture Centre coming out the clear winner. The Scouts and Cubs took part in the Erne County Quiz with 4th Fermanagh winning the Scout Plaque.

Spring saw all sections hold a pancake night with some great flipping being had and lots of Nutella Pancakes being eaten. We had 6 Scouts take part in a John Muir Award program in Crom Estate. Great reports on skills learned and information taught from all involved. Cubs and Scouts took part in a county hike, the Scouts doing a 10km hike over the Cuaigh Way and the Cubs doing a 5km hike in Florencecourt. The Cubs used this hike to raise funds for their camps through sponsorship cards. This month also saw a new County Commissioner taking the reins (Christina).

In April the Beavers and Cubs took part in separate skills day in Castle Archdale. Very successful days had by all involved. The group also took on a new Beaver Leader this month, Ciara Brennan. She was so keen to get going she even dialed into the last training session remotely from Poland while on holiday. That is dedication!

Late spring leaders took part in overnight training through Scouting Ireland in preparation for Isle of Man Camp in July. This only goes further to demonstrate how dedicated the leaders are to ensuring the welfare and safeguarding of all scouting children. This month also saw the Scouts start some water sessions, canoeing at the Share Centre. This ran for 4 weeks. Canoeing also got underway for Beavers starting their sessions, huge excitement at that. Beavers also did a county overnight camp with the Erne County at the Share Centre.

July saw 36 Scouts, Cubs, and 11 leaders Camp set sail for Isle of Man from 4th July to 10th July. A fantastic trip was had by all scouts and leaders included. A great center and many activities experienced such as coastineering and high ropes. Activities we could not offer here. Some pictures can be seen on the back wall of the hall.

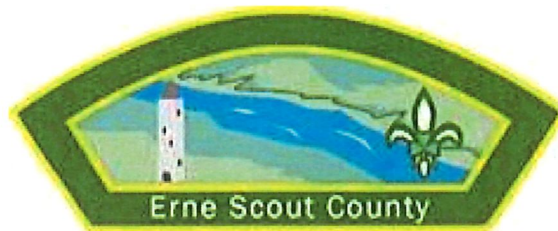
