The Trustees present their report and the unaudited financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 October 2023.

Structure, Governance and management

Club Down is a charitable unincorporated association governed by its own constitution.

Objectives and activities

- a) To advance public education in and to preserve the Gaelic heritage, language and culture;
and
- b) The promotion of community participation in healthy recreation, in particular by the provision of facilities for the playing Gaelic sports.

Achievements and performance

The financial year 2022/23 was a very challenging year for the charity in the midst of a cost of living crisis and depressed business environment.

The charity still managed to return a modest surplus and commenced preparations for the establishment of a business forum which should yield substantial revenue in the future years.

Financial Review

The Cumann An Duin charity income from activities for the 12 month period ending October 31 2023 was £3,621.

The Expenditure during the year on charitable activities was £2,650.

At the start of the year there was £32,734 of unrestricted funds, the movement during the year of funds was £971 leaving an unrestricted fund balance at the 31st October 2023 of £33,705.


