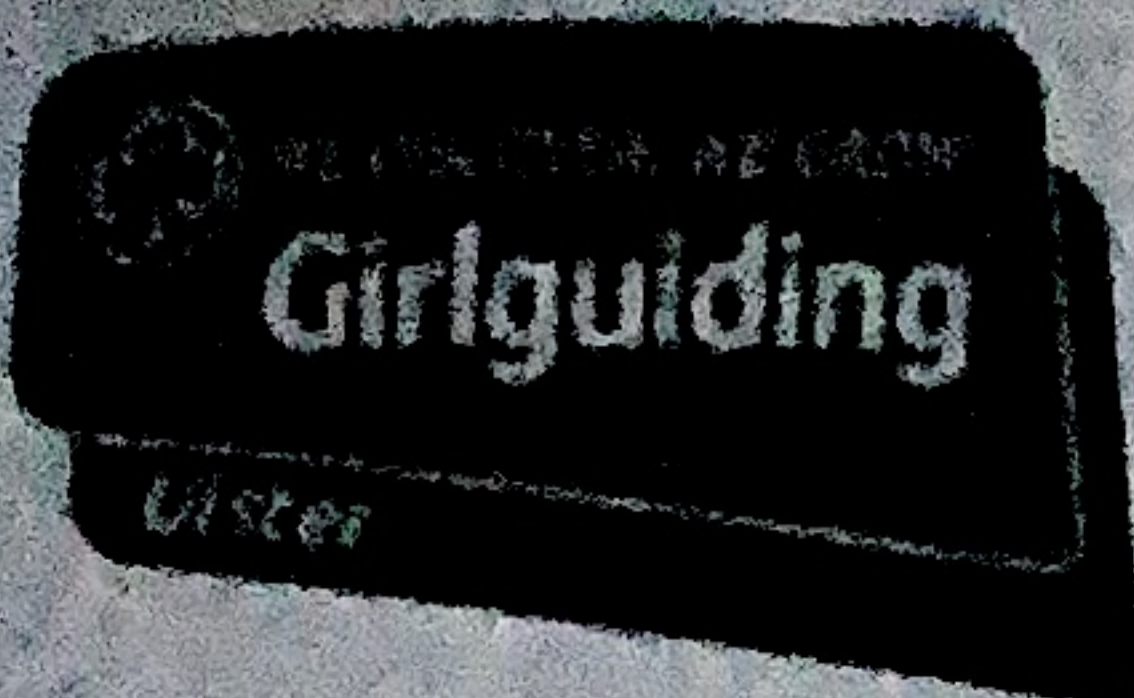

A summary of the Charity's main activities to further its purposes for the public benefit and the main achievements in the year:

Membership was 14 girls, 3 volunteer adult leaders and 2 volunteer young leaders in training. We completed numerous Girlguiding approved unit meeting activities, had quizzes and crafts for Easter, Halloween, Christmas, St Valentines, St Patrick's Day and Mother's Day. We celebrated Diwali making candles to celebrate this cultural festival, we participate in a sponsored walk in Eglinton learning the local history of the village whilst raising vital funds for charity. Our young leaders did a games night showing the girls different board games and introducing games from different cultures. We went for a trip to Lorne Estate to participate in the Programme Pioneers event in which the girls enjoyed travelling by bus and took part in various activities such as archaeology, around the world in a day exploration and learning to read a map with grid referencing. The girls were awarded their Jobs & Archaeology badge and also on their Skill Builders: Have Adventures badge.
