The girls took part in a varied programme of activities including – Nature Badge work, themed crafts, a visit to the local RNLI station, a trip to the beach, an event joining with Rainbows from the district to celebrate Thinking Day, a 'No Sleep Sleep Over', which enabled them to experience the fun of a guiding residential without having to spend the night away from home.
