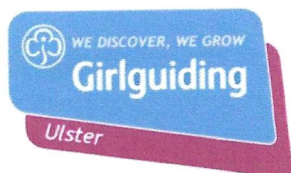

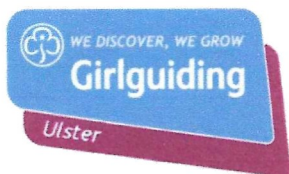
Public benefit.
