Charitable Purposes

Limavady Independent Methodist Church was founded for the purpose of preaching the gospel, which is recognised by the Charity Commission as a charitable purpose having a public benefit.

The principal object of the charitable purpose is promoting and advancing the Christian faith as stated in Chapter 2 of the Constitution of the Fellowship of Independent Methodist Churches.

There is no private benefit coming from this purpose. The beneficiaries are the general public, of all ages, from around the district of Limavady and beyond as we have visitors from further afield.

Main Activities for Public Benefit

Weekly Sunday services are held so that both regular attendees and visitors can hear and benefit from the teaching of God's Word and how it can be applied to our lives.


We also enjoy Fellowship over teas that we have from time to time where visitors are welcome.

There is a Sunday School where children are taught the truths of the bible and is open to all children. We held a "Holiday Bible Club" for the youth and a "Fun Day" for children of primary school age, and their parents, that they could enjoy the outreach of the fellowship and become familiar with church activities.

A "Women's Meeting" has recommenced enabling women from the church, and the local community, to attend and hear from guest speakers regarding Christian outreach.
