The year ending 31 March 2025 was a good year for fundraising and we were able to keep our bank balance over the £2k mark at the end of the year.

Dress down days were from previous 21/22 year and also Christmas 2024 and have continued to bring in income for the PSA and school and is an easy way to add to our total income received.

[easyfundraising.com](https://www.easyfundraising.com) needs promoted more this year as it has usually always brought in donations but nothing in this current year. This is something we can promote further this coming year with new and existing parents, families and staff members.

Our main sources of income this year were from the Easter Raffle, which continues to be a successful fundraiser and we received two substantial donations from families which was extremely generous.

We received two grants - one from Summerhill Foundation that was used to purchase special bikes with stabilisers which are much more accessible for our children. We also carried out the blue token voting scheme in Tescos/Groundworks and came 2nd place receiving a grant from groundworks for £1000 - this was used on purchasing 4 new iPads for the school.

We also had the exciting new arrival in the form of Prince our lovely school therapy dog. The PSA gave £1000 towards his deposit and used the income from the Easter Raffle to pay part of his cost of purchase.

We were able to pay for an ice cream van to visit school and donate money for school prizes.

For the next accounting year we will continue to apply for grants and ask parents and staff to help us in any way they can. We also intend to bring back the annual family fun day which was always so popular with our kids families. (At the time of writing this the funday has already taken place and was a great success).

I want to thank all the PSA trustees, PSA members, parents, staff and any family members who have helped us with our fundraising efforts. We would not be able to provide all the amazing resources for our children without your help.
