## **Charity purpose**

The organisation is established to promote the arts and culture for the benefit of the people of the city of

Belfast and surrounding areas (hereinafter called the 'area of benefit') by provision of a central neutral arts centre venue with a focus on developing community based arts.

a) To bring together and coordinate artists and groups to share skills in the art of photography, music, dance, film, performance and visual art and art in general.

b) To encourage appreciation of the arts and stimulate the artistic creativity of people in the area of benefit by provision of artistic performances, training, support and facilities for artistic expression.

The organisation carries out its purpose by providing a venue for programmes of visual and performance art exhibitions and events in a safe and inclusive neutral location for the general public of Belfast and beyond.

## **Activity and achievements.**

The period 21/22 has been very challenging for the gallery as we were only able to resume our activities on June 21 after a six month lockdown. The number of visitors decreased considerably with the restrictions. However we notice an increase from the beginning of 2022.

The demand for studio space also decreased too during this period but we saw an increase of inquiries from February 22. The launch of our website was a success and contributed to the boost of the gallery profile on social media. Two of the exhibitions were sponsored by the Arts council (L Reihill, F Gertenbach) and we managed to put together our very popular bi-annual group show Melting Pot. Artcetera also helped a group of film students to put together their first mini festival and we were delighted to facilitate a new local craft shop startup Kingsroads Studios with their first solo show.

## **End of the year financial review 21/22**

We started the year with a balance of £10311.89 and our balance at the end of the financial year was £10398.78

This situation allowed us to continue our activity serenely in the next financial year.
