The Way Church's charitable purpose is the spread of religion. As in previous years, we continued to do this through our most common regular practices of public services and weekly ministries, but also some special events.

Public Worship Services

Our primary means of our charitable purpose is through public worship services, which take place on a Sunday morning in the Town Hall and a Wednesday night in Foundry House. Numbers kept consistent, and it was great to baptise 3 people in the summer.

Children's & Youth Work

Our youth work saw an aspect of expansion as another related to ministry to young people started. Not only do the young people meet bi-weekly (1st year to 18's), the older age group also meet (16's-25's) as a way to keep connected and grow in their faith together.


Special Outreach

We ran a 321 course in a local café owned by a family in our church. This course is specifically designed to introduce and explain the Christian faith to outsiders. It also is a great tool to help Christians share their faith more effectively. It was good to make new connections with people through this.

We also got the opportunity to go into 3 local primary schools with the "Amazing Journey", which is an interactive Bible story presentation. Over the 3 schools around 500 children were spoken to, with 70 requesting Bibles of their own, through a parental consent form filled in through the school.

The above activities are an accurate reflection of activity during 2024, with the trustees all having regard to the Commission's Public benefit requirement statutory guidance. All requirements in the area of health and safety, including safeguarding measures, were adhered to.
