The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008), the Companies Act 2006 and following the recommendations in Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP 2005) issued in March 2005.

c) Incoming Resources

Incoming resources are included in the Statement of Financial Activities in the period in which they are receivable.

Grant income is included in the period of receipt.

d) Expenditure

Expenditure is recognised in the period in which it is incurred and is allocated to expense headings on a direct basis.

e) Funds

The charitable company has two types of funds for which it is responsible. A definition of the two types of funds is as follows:

(i) Restricted Funds

Funds received which are earmarked by the donor for specific purposes. Such purposes are within the overall aims of the company.

(ii) Unrestricted Funds

Funds which are expendable at the discretion of the directors and have been designated for specific purposes to further the objects of the charity.

2. INCOMING RESOURCES

All incoming resources are included on the Statement of Financial Activities when the charity is legally entitled to the income.

- **Grants**
Revenue grants are credited to incoming resources on the earlier of the date of when they are received or when they are receivable.
- **Donations**
Donations are credited to incoming resources in the period to which they relate.
