On 22nd of June 2024 The entire KGG community spent a whole day bonding and sharing Gospel at Giants cause way which ended with a sumptuous dinner

**WOMEN AID COLERIANE SUPPORT** – Quarterly Donation The Women Aid Coleraine was adopted since the inception of the Charity and a monthly support with food items and essentials as need arises. We have series of letter of appreciation from the organization

**HALLOW HIM 2023 – 29/10/2023 and 27/10/2024.** This was 4 hours reach out to Coleraine community attracting attendance of between 120 and 250 people at the Coleraine Town Hall. It features singing and entertainment with refreshment. The program was duly approved by the Causeway Borough Council and successfully done with no incidence. There was Hoody distribution to all participants in the singing and prayer sessions.

**COLERAINE ENVIRONMENTAL CLEAN UP – 22nd June 2024.** The Church is situated on 24 Railway the road Coleraine and we have observed accumulated dirt ranging from cigarette butt, drinks cans and bottled toilet tissues and many more. This day was dedicated to cleaning the neighbourhood starting from the railway station, and its adjoining car park, the Railway road stretching from rail crossing up to the end of the Lodge road traffic light were thoroughly cleaned and all collected refuse disposed at the Coleraine disposal centre

**RCCG FESTIVAL OF LIFE ANNUAL MEETEING - EXCEL CENTRE LONDON.** The Charity has an annual support for the festival of live attracting over 3000 young adults in England as part of its sponsorship for youth development.

**ULSTERS UNIVERSITY - COLERAINE CAMPUS RCCG.** - KGG sponsored mass distribution of faith based literature to address the yarning of Christ based faithful both national and international. The various literatures posted on designated public display boards.

**WEEKLY PRAYER MEETING & SUNDAY MEETINGS.** From inception this program has attracted families for bible studies during the week and Sunday services that has motivated healthy social development of the children as they have their session while the adults likewise worship and fellowship together promoting mutual and loving coexistence of cross-cultural set up spanning Africa (Nigeria, Ghana, South Africa, Zambia, Cameroon, Eritrea), India, Philippines, and the host community in Coleraine

### Summary of the Main Achievements of the Charity for the Year:

We have a centre which we provide counselling and provide information, e.g., we use the centre for counselling and as a distribution point for all the food we distribute to various individuals in need.

We also ran a street outreach programme which currently involves going out on the streets on a Friday evening in groups to show care and love to people sleeping rough in the street and to provide basic essentials.

This is all evidenced through numbers of people that we have helped. We plan in the future to develop a Training and Learning programme and a drop-in centre/Cafe where people can meet and talk about their problems and we also plan to reach out to the sick.

## Financial Review

### Brief Statement of the Charity's Policy on Reserves:

It is the policy of RCCG-King of Glory and Grace Church to hold in reserves the equivalent of two months general running costs. It is also our policy to hold an amount for likely outreach works at the next inspection. In view of the forthcoming street retreat next year we have allocated £2000 to reserves to cover our involvement. This policy will be reviewed in twelve month's time apart from the Learning and training project element which will be reviewed in six months time when the situation is clearer.
