Aims and Purposes of the Charity.

Dundrum Cricket Club provides facilities, amenities and access to equipment, to anyone wishing to participate in Cricket both competitively and recreationally within Dundrum and surrounding areas of Co Down. Members take part in training and skills developments and have an opportunity to socialise, enhance their skills and engage in enjoyable creative and recreation activities.

Our key objectives as a charity are;

To promote the amateur sport of cricket by providing facilities for playing cricket, including provision of coaching, equipment, and competitive opportunities.

To encourage active participation in cricket, particularly among young people, and to develop their sporting skills and personal development.

To foster social interaction and community cohesion within Dundrum and the wider area through sporting activities.

Recruitment of trustees.

Trustees are recruited through nomination by club member to the committee, this is carried out at the AGM.

Activities and objectives for the period November 1st 2023 to October 31st 2024.

During the past year, the club focused on consolidating its existing operations and fostering grassroots development rather than undertaking large capital projects.

A primary objective for the year was the successful establishment of an Under 17 girls' team, providing a new pathway for young female cricketers to play competitive matches and further develop their skills within a supportive environment.

As a club we have also made a commitment to provide access to coaching from our governing body, this has helped us to nurture and develop young and future coaches.

The newly qualified coaches along with the establishment of an U17 girls team has seen two of our young members selected to play at both provincial and international levels.

Once again we have made The Meadow available to local schools and community groups, inviting local schools to a cricket 'finals days' and providing the pavilion for other community groups to use.
