

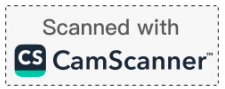

Independent examiner's report to the charity trustees of Belfast Suleymaniye Educational Trust

I report on the accounts of the Trust for the year ended 30 April 2023, which are set out on pages 1 to 2.
