



Trustees Report

The Trustees resent their report of the Friends of Ampertaine Primary School for the ten-month period ending 31 August 2024. These accounts have been presented for ten months as the year end date for the Charity has been amended to 31 August each year to align with the school year. This change has been approved by the Charity Commission for Northern Ireland.

Introduction

Friends of Ampertaine Primary School PTA (the PTA) is made up of a membership of both Parents and Teachers with a number of members also acting as Trustees of the Charity. Three members are appointed to hold positions of Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer. Members of the PTA give their time voluntarily and work collaboratively to raise funds that are directly given back to Ampertaine Primary School through buying equipment and funding activities which benefit each child attending the School.
