

Objectives and activities

The objectives of the charity are to increase social skills, improve emotional well-being and increase spiritual development in the lives of local young people. This purpose will also provide improvements to overall community life. The beneficiaries of this are children and young people as defined by Government policy in Northern Ireland living in Creggan, Derry.

The charity aims to provide a programme of activities, both indoor and outdoor and cater for a wide range of leisure and recreational activities. It also aims to provide information, guidance and support to all the young people of the area, whether members or not. A major component of this will be the inclusion of a cross-community initiative.
