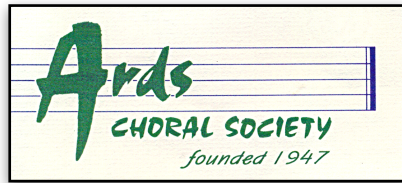

## **TRUSTEES' REPORT 2023-2024**

The 2023-2024 year proved to be another successful season for Ards Choral Society, seeing a substantial growth in choir membership, whilst still maintaining focus on musicianship, comradeship, social and local relevance and supporting new and upcoming talent. Committee objectives for the year included a desire to expand the remit in the growth of the choir, the promotion of concerts in the wider area using various social media platforms and liaison with outside organisations to promote these aims.

One highlight of the year was the very successful *Celebration of Christmas in Words and Music* which not only presented some challenging Christmas music which Ards Choral Society had rarely focused on in its 77-year history, but also resulted in a sell-out performance with a strong social dimension. The concert took place in the Queen's Hall Newtownards and guest performers included Mary McCabe (Soprano), Aaron O'Hare (Tenor) and Enzo Gowdy (Piano and Violin and North Down Rotary Club's Young Primary School Musician of the Year, 2023). The narrator was Walker Ewart.

Music for the Easter Concert, Rutter's challenging *Requiem*, combined with Passion Music from Handel's *Messiah* and some lovely new pieces by Will Todd and Dan Forrest provoked much emotional response among members of the audience in St Mark's Parish Church, Newtownards and, indeed, inspired the concept of a concert of smaller pieces around a theme of reflection or meditation, thereby shaping this year's forthcoming *In Paradisum* concert, also to be held in St Mark's on Thursday 6 March 2025.

The return of our traditional Supper Theatre Concert in May 2024, with its twin foci of celebrating 100 years of Walt Disney Corporation and the 100th anniversary of George Gershwin's *Rhapsody in Blue*, featured two new artistes, Naomi Smyth and Mark Leeman, along with Gillian McCutcheon and young Cavan on clarinet, was thoroughly enjoyed and appreciated by all, audience and choir alike. The wine and cheese refreshments were also welcomed by the Queen's Hall audience of 170!

One of the biggest successes of the year, however, was the large-scale development of the use of social media platforms for publicity purposes and for recruitment. This resulted in significantly increased choir membership (to 70 members) and outreach to a much wider range of audiences. Work completed on Society archive materials, dating back to its origins in 1947, sorted and donated to the Public Records Office of Northern Ireland, can also be highlighted as another form of publicity and community outreach with photos, written materials and financial ledgers now on display for the general public. Outreach and making links with other organisations and groups remains a priority for 2024-25.

In conclusion, 2023-24 was very busy, rewarding and challenging year for all at Ards Choral Society and sincerest thanks must go to the Musical Director, Ian Bell, and accompanist, Joanne Cruise, for their huge respective contributions to weekly rehearsals and concerts, sharing freely their special and unique talents. Similarly, the Chair and Committee have worked tirelessly to ensure the successful running of events throughout the year, but above all, thanks must go the choir members themselves who work hard every Thursday evening at rehearsals and whose dedication and commitment continue to ensure the longevity of the Society.

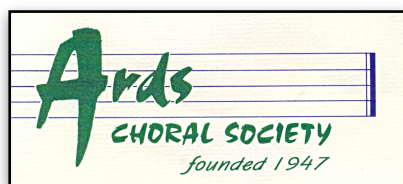

## **TRUSTEES' REPORT 2022-2023**

**(as delivered at the Annual General Meeting, 26 October 2023)**

The Chair began by reminding members that the overall aim of 2022-23 for Ards Choral Society (ACS) was diversification, experimentation and consideration of new directions and links. Specific priorities set by the committee/trustees related to recruitment, publicity and outreach.

Diversification and experimentation were addressed through implementing a 'non-traditional' programme (compared with previous years), including a Christmas Concert of varying musical styles, a joint performance of Stainer's *The Crucifixion* at Easter with another choir and an experimental Open Evening in May, providing guests with the opportunity to experience a typical ACS rehearsal. Each of the events was very well-supported and all attracted new members.

The Christmas Concert had grown out of the previous year's small, in-house event involving the singing of carols, some readings and enjoying some seasonal refreshments. The event of December 2022 expanded the initial concept and engaged Mary McCabe as Soprano soloist, Walker Ewart as Narrator and our own Joanne accompanying the choir in a programme of music from Part 1 Messiah and some new arrangements of carols. The catering committee provided a lovely festive supper for a very full Queen's Hall in Newtownards.

The Spring programme centred on a joint venture with Ballyholme Parish Church choir, in a performance of John Stainer's *The Crucifixion*. While many members had sung this over the years in their own church choirs or with other groups, Ards Choral Society had never performed the work. Our own Stanley Officer joined Paddy Crothers (Bass) and Martin O'Hagan (Tenor) in this deeply moving telling of the Passion of Christ. The evening performance also included some new music by Will Todd and a performance of Roberton's *All in the April Evening*. The church was full to capacity for the evening and the performance was extremely well-received. Finally, the Open Evening in May provided an evening of fun, an opportunity to display a variety of repertoire and gave potential new members a taste of what ACS practices involved. A very pleasing number of guests joined us and some have now become members!

With regard to recruitment, the Chair reported that numbers had grown from 55 post-pandemic, to 62 in 2022-23. This was largely the result of an active recruitment drive by the committee via wider use of social media, newspaper publicity, word of mouth and the Open Evening. Events were publicised widely in the Newtownards Chronicle, on local Council and other relevant websites and through a much more proactive approach to the use of WhatsApp and other platforms.

In terms of outreach, links were established with Ballyholme Parish Church choir and the Rotary Club of North Down. Developing further links with other organisations/groups remains a priority for 2023-24, along with further consolidation of diversification, experimentation, recruitment, publicity and marketing.

The Chair concluded by thanking the committee members for their hard work and support during the year, the Musical Director and accompanist for their massive respective contributions to a successful year and all choir members for engaging actively with the difficult concept of change and taking incremental steps toward diversification and experimentation.
