

**As the Independent examiner to the financial reports of Warrenpoint Women's Group registered charity number NI109291, I would like to reiterate my responsibility to the group.**

**The annual reports which I receive from the charity trustees of Warrenpoint Women's Group are in line with their constitution and the reporting procedures within.**

I report on the accounts of Warrenpoint Women's Group for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2024, which are set out herein.

#### **Respective responsibilities of charity trustees and examiner**

As the charity's trustees you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the Charities Act (Northern Ireland) 2008.

It is my responsibility to:

- Examine the accounts under section 65 of the Charities Act
- Follow the procedures laid down in the general directions given by the Commission under section 65(9)(b) of the Charities Act

#### **Basis of independent examiner's report**

I have examined your charity accounts as required under section 65 of the Charities Act and my examination was carried out in accordance with the general Directions given by the Charity Commission for Northern Ireland under section 65(9)(b) of the Charities Act.

My examination included a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records.
