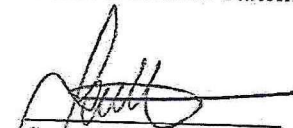
The Committee present their report and the unaudited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2024. The Kirk Session and Committee Members at the date of this report, are set out on page 1.

NOTES

1. Principle accounting policies

The following accounting policies have been applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the financial statements.

1.1 Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with United Kingdom generally accepted accounting practice. Accounting standards generally accepted in the United Kingdom, for preparing financial statements giving a true and fair view, are those published by the Institute of Chartered Accountants in Ireland and issued by the Accounting Standards Board.

1.2 Financial Statements

The financial statements only include a Statement of Income and Expenditure. It was felt that little would be gained by the preparation of a Balance Sheet. However, a note is included of all bank balances as at the year end.

1.3 Incoming Resources

All incoming resources are included in the statement of financial activities when the Church is entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy.

1.4 Resources Expended

Expenditure is recognised on an actual basis. Expenditure includes any VAT which cannot be recovered, and is reported as part of the expenditure to which it relates.

Expenditure comprises those costs incurred by the Church in the delivery of its activities. It includes both costs that can be allocated directly to such activities and those costs of an indirect nature necessary to support them.
