Objectives and Activities

Our Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) aims to support the school community through fundraising, social events, and providing resources and opportunities that enhance the pupils' experience.

In 2024, we organised a variety of events to engage our school community and raise funds:

1. **January Movie Night:** Organised as a fundraising event, providing a fun evening for students.
2. **Half-Term Disco:** Another popular disco event, also featuring a tuck shop for snacks and treats.
3. **Mother's Day Gift Sale:** Offered pupils the opportunity to buy thoughtful gifts for Mother's Day.

7. **Halloween Costume Sale:** A pre-loved costume sale aimed at reducing waste and supporting families.
8. **Halloween Disco:** A fun-filled evening for pupils to celebrate Halloween, complete with a tuck shop.
9. **Christmas Fair:** Hosted stalls, including Santa's Grotto and reindeer food. We also ran a tea and coffee stall, selling a hot drink with a traybake for £2.
10. **Nativity Play:** Supported the school's annual production by running a tea and coffee stall, selling a hot drink with a traybake for £2.
11. **Christmas Decoration:** Raised funds by inviting pupils to participate for £1 per entry, with a Christmas themed colouring competition.

Expenditure: £3,100.55


