Trustees' report (including Directors' report)

For the Period ended 31 March 2025

The trustees present their annual report and financial statements for the period ended 31 March 2025.

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the accounting policies set out in note 1 to the financial statements and comply with the charity's governing document, the Companies Act 2006 and "Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)".

Objectives and activities

Principal Activity

The principal activity of the charity is to provide practical projects that help both people and the planet. We have a focus on mental health and wellbeing and to work to address the effects of both social and economic inequality on a local and global scope. The groups that we set up to serve are primarily, but not exclusively to are LGBTQIA+ community, Women, Refugees & Asylum seekers, Young people, Older people, People experiencing homelessness.

Public benefit

In line with its stated aims and objectives, the trustees are confident that the charity is undertaking activities which provide public benefit.

Achievements and Performance

Financial Review

Total income for the period was £17,015 (2024: £Nil). Donations amounted to £17,015 (2024: £Nil).

Total expenditure for the period was £8,894 (2024: £Nil). The cost of charitable activities amounted to £8,894 (2024: £Nil).

Net income for the period amounted to £8,121 (2024: £Nil) consisting of unrestricted net income of £8,121 (2024: £Nil).

Reserves policy

It is policy of the charity to maintain free reserves which matches the needs of the charity, both at the current time and the foreseeable future. This provides sufficient funds to cover running costs. Free reserves are those unrestricted reserves not designed nor invested in fixed assets which are available for general use.

1 Accounting policies

Charity information

Show Some Love Ltd is a private company limited by guarantee incorporated in Northern Ireland. The registered office is 171-175 Victoria Street, Belfast, BT1 4HS.

1.1 Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the charity's governing document, the Companies Act 2006 and "Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)". The charity is a Public Benefit Entity as defined by FRS 102.

The charity has taken advantage of the provisions in the SORP for charities applying FRS 102 Update Bulletin 1 not to prepare a Statement of Cash Flows.

The financial statements are prepared in sterling, which is the functional currency of the charity. Monetary amounts in these financial statements are rounded to the nearest £.

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention. The principal accounting policies adopted are set out below.

1.2 Going concern

At the time of approving the financial statements, the trustees have a reasonable expectation that the charity has adequate resources to continue in operational existence for the foreseeable future. Thus the trustees continue to adopt the going concern basis of accounting in preparing the financial statements.

1.3 Charitable funds

Unrestricted funds are available for use at the discretion of the trustees in furtherance of their charitable objectives.

Restricted funds are subject to specific conditions by donors or grantors as to how they may be used.

1.4 Income

Income is recognised when the charity is legally entitled to it after any performance conditions have been met, the amounts can be measured reliably, and it is probable that income will be received.

Cash donations are recognised on receipt. Other donations are recognised once the charity has been notified of the donation, unless performance conditions require deferral of the amount.

1.5 Expenditure

Expenditure is recognised once there is a legal or constructive obligation to make a payment to a third party, it is probable that settlement will be required and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Irrecoverable VAT is charged as a cost against the activity for which the expenditure was incurred.

1.5 Expenditure (continued)

Expenditure on charitable activities includes the costs of services undertaken to further the purposes of the charity and their associated support costs. Support costs are those functions that assist the work of the charity but do not directly undertake charitable activities.

1.6 Stocks

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

1.7 Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents include cash in hand, deposits held at call with banks, other short-term liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less, and bank overdrafts. Bank overdrafts are shown within borrowings in current liabilities.

1.8 Tax

As a charity, the company benefits from various exemptions afforded by tax legislation. It is therefore not liable to corporation tax on income or gains falling due within those exemptions.

2 Critical accounting estimates and judgements

In the application of the charity's accounting policies, the trustees are required to make judgements, estimates and assumptions about the carrying amount of assets and liabilities that are not readily apparent from other sources. The estimates and associated assumptions are based on historical experience and other factors that are considered to be relevant. Actual results may differ from these estimates.

The estimates and underlying assumptions are reviewed on an ongoing basis. Revisions to accounting estimates are recognised in the period in which the estimate is revised where the revision affects only that period, or in the period of the revision and future periods where the revision affects both current and future periods.
