Overview

The Church has continued to actively carry out its charitable and religious purposes in accordance with the objectives and provisions set out within its Constitution. Throughout the reporting period, the Church has maintained a programme of regular worship, prayer, community engagement and charitable activity, demonstrating its continued operation as an active Christian ministry.

Worship and Religious Activities

The Church continues to hold regular weekly services of prayer and worship, including mid-week prayer and worship meetings and services on Sundays. These gatherings provide opportunities for members and the wider community to come together for Christian worship, prayer, biblical teaching, fellowship and spiritual support.

These activities remain central to the Church's constitutional objectives and demonstrate that the organisation continues to actively pursue its stated religious purposes.

Charitable and Community Support

The Church has also participated in charitable initiatives supporting other ministries and communities internationally. In particular, members of the Church have taken part in the Seven Summits charitable challenge, helping to raise funds for ministries involved in the construction and development of churches in the Philippines.

This initiative provided practical financial support to other Christian ministries while also encouraging members of the Church to participate in charitable and community-focused activities.

Engagement with the Local Community

The Church has continued to make efforts to reach out to the local community through the distribution of Christian literature and other forms of community engagement. This outreach has provided opportunities to make contact with local residents and to offer Christian information, encouragement and support.

As a direct result of this engagement, the Church was approached by a local community association and asked to hold a Bible camp for members of the local community. This invitation demonstrates the positive relationships being developed between the Church and the wider community and provides an opportunity for the Church to further its religious and community outreach.

Development of Church Premises

The Church is also progressing towards securing premises of its own in Portadown. A lease for suitable premises has nearly been secured and the process is currently underway. The premises are presently undergoing renovation in preparation for their future use by the Church.

Having dedicated premises will provide the Church with a permanent base from which it can expand its weekly worship and prayer services, undertake community outreach, hold Bible studies and camps, and develop further charitable and ministry activities.

The Church has therefore continued to actively fulfil the purposes established within its Constitution through regular prayer and worship, Christian teaching, charitable fundraising, international support, community outreach and the development of facilities for future ministry.

The Church remains committed to serving its congregation and the wider community and is continuing to develop its activities and capacity. The securing and renovation of dedicated premises in Portadown represents an important next step in enabling the Church to expand its religious, charitable and community work.

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
