To use arts and crafts as a tool to build confidence, self expression and social engagement among children, teenagers and young adults with or awaiting an ASD diagnosis. 6. To advocate for users of our charity, raise awareness of the skills and abilities of our young people and participate in local forums to provide input on services and support within the area.
