(3) The Charity aims to support access to bereavement, trauma-informed and relevant appropriate training for staff working in these dedicated spaces. The goal is to ensure trained staff are available to provide appropriate care and guidance to families experiencing sudden loss, so as to promote and protect families and avoid re-traumatization.
