organisations including providing training and development. 5.6 To work proactively to reduce abuse and its impact by working with perpetrators to support changes in behaviour. 5.7 To ensure the sustainability of the organisation by identifying sources of grant funding and fundraising. and 5.8 To improve understanding of abuse and trauma, the quality of abuse and trauma services and the experience of people using abuse and trauma services by being a 'best practice' organisation supporting other organisations to improve their practice by the delivery of consultancy services, specific training and development.
